The Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District (MPRPD) is seeking Outdoor Educators for its "Let's Go Outdoors!" (LGO!) Adventure Activities Guide.

Connect with The Park District as it builds its newest LGO! guide geared to get residents, neighbors and friends out of doors. The MPRPD is looking for enthusiastic, skilled individuals who want to share their knowledge and interests about the Monterey Bay region. If you have a passion for the wonders of the outdoors and want to share your interests in nature-related programming and recreational activities, please complete a proposal application (available online) with a course description.

Priority consideration is given to programs that are:

- Supportive of the mission of the Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District.
- Conservation, sustainability, and ecologically oriented.
- Explorative and share information about the richness and diversity of the Monterey Bay area's natural and cultural history.
- Educational, inquiry-based and thematic in approach.
- Demonstrated professionally, as instructors must be positive role models.

Completed applications will be reviewed carefully. Selected instructors will be contacted for an in-person interview.

All instructors will work under contracts, which will specify the services being provided including date, time, location, and program fee.

Fees and instructor payment are negotiable and will be finalized prior to contract signing. Instructors will be subject to a background investigation, including fingerprinting. Programs will be advertised in The Park District catalogue.
