- Conservation, sustainability, and ecologically oriented.
- Explorative in the richness and diversity of the Monterey Peninsula's natural and cultural history.
- Educational, inquiry-based and thematic in approach.
- Professionally presented, as instructors must be positive role models.

Completed proposals will be reviewed carefully. Selected instructors will be contacted for an in-person interview.

All instructors will work under contract, which will specify the services being provided including date, time, location, and class size.

Instructors will be subject to a fingerprint background check.

Approved proposals will be advertised in MPRPD's "Let's Go Outdoors!" Adventure Activities Guide.
