SUBJECT: **Operations and Maintenance Division Update**

REPORT: **TREES DOWN:** Rangers continue to remove fallen trees after each winter storm. Recently, a large dead pine tree fell onto the temporary fence panels bordering the trail corridor at Rancho Canada, crushing 4 fence panels. Gabilan inmates were utilized to clear/remove the tree and replace the fence panels. Smaller trees were reported on other trails including Gabilan and Terrace, which were removed by Ranger staff.

FIRST AID/CPR/AED RECERTIFICATION: All Rangers were recertified in proper CPR/AED/First-aid applications. This course is part of the Rangers bi-annual training curriculum. Seasonal Ranger Hatton Vandervort received his initial certification by attending the 6-hour course just before leaving for PC832 training in Fresno, CA. (which authorizes Ranger staff to issue citations)

PILE BURNING AT PCRP: Cal Fire is in the process of burning brush piles that were created during the Palo Corona Fuelbreak Project. The California National Guard has been contracted by Cal Fire to complete the pile burning, while Cal Fire engine and inmate crews are busy finishing the fuel mitigation work as part of the license agreement the MPRPD Board approved in April 2019.

CACHAGUA WATER SYSTEM: Improvements to the Cachagua Water System are schedule to begin February 2nd. This project will supply the CUSD Cachagua school and the Cachagua Community Park with potable water. Improvements will be completed by Don Chapin Company within 120 days of the notice to proceed.
