**Monterey, CA., May 31, 2018**— Garland Ranch Regional Park, home to over 500 species of flowering plants will be the place for Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District's 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Summer Wildflower Show on Saturday and Sunday, June 9-10.

On display from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day will be hundreds of species of flowers from Garland Ranch Regional Park, Frog Pond Wetland Preserve, Marina Dunes Preserve and Palo Corona Regional Park. The Wildflower Show will be held at the Garland Ranch Regional Park Visitor Center patio.

Additional activities include:

- Free Volunteer Naturalist led wildflower walks at 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. both days.

Access to the Wildflower Show, park, arboretum, native plant garden and Visitor Center are free.

Garland Park is located at 700 W. Carmel Valley Road, 8.6 miles east of Highway 1. Admission to Garland Ranch Regional Park and all Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District properties is free of charge.
