

DISCUSSION

The District has reinitiated its partnership with the California Conservation Corps (CCC) to accelerate wildfire resilience and other resource management projects across District lands. By leveraging CALFIRE-funded CCC forestry crews, this collaboration has already successfully established defensible space and roadside fuel barriers around high priority infrastructure at Garland Ranch Regional Park, including the primary Ranger Station, the historic Cooper Barn, and the Kahn Ranch building complex. These crews provide a high-capacity workforce to augment the stewardship of District properties. Chad Harris, CCC Conservation Supervisor, will provide an overview of

these recent accomplishments and outline how the CCC's local programs can continue to support the District's mission.
