**SUBJECT:** Approval to Release Request for Bids for Winter Storm  
Damage Repairs at de Dampierre Park

---

#### SUMMARY

As a result of the January 2023 flood event, de Dampierre Park sustained damages that require larger equipment to repair than MPRPD possesses. Thus, staff is requesting approval from the Board to release a Request for Proposals for winter storm damage repairs at de Dampierre Park.

#### DISCUSSION

de Dampierre Park, located along Paso Hondo in Carmel Valley, CA, suffered significant storm damages as a result of the January 2023 flood event, including loss of the parking lot aggregate surfacing, parking bollards, and chain-link fence damages. Staff continues to coordinate with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) toward addressing repairs and recovering as much cost associated with the event as possible. Staff recently confirmed with CDFW that this project is not subject to the notification

requirements pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, which was delaying completion of this project. Thus, staff is requesting approval to release a Request for Proposals for FEMA-related winter storm damages at de Dampierre Park, with the following scope:

**Spread, grade, moisten, and compact 375 cubic yards of class 2 aggregate over a 1.25-acre parking area using a contractor-provided Motor Grader, Water truck (with water source), and Vibratory Roller.**

A mandatory site visit will be scheduled where each attendee may walk the site, ask questions, take photos, etc. Based on the outcome, staff is planning to bring a request for contract approval to the Board for consideration at the July 2026 Board meeting.

### **RECOMMENDED ACTION**

Staff respectfully recommends that the Board review and approve the release of a Request for Proposals for winter storm damage repairs at de Dampierre Park.
