NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to the provisions of Section 5529 of the California Public Resources Code, that a general District election to be consolidated with the Presidential General Election will be held for the Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District on the 3rd day of November 2020, to select a successor for three (3) offices of the Board of Directors to be elected in Wards 1, 2 and 3 of the Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District.

Generally, the wards include the following areas:

Ward 1 (Marina, northern Fort Ord)

Ward 2 (Seaside, northern Sand City, southern Fort Ord)

Ward 3 (Monterey, Del Rey Oaks, southwest Seaside, southern Sand City)

The qualifications required by the principal act for each office for which candidates are nominated are:

Candidate must be a registered voter of the district or property owner in the district and registered voter in California.

All filing documents may be obtained and/or executed at [Monterey County Elections](#), between July 13, 2020 and August 7, 2020. If the incumbent fails to qualify for office by 5:00 p.m., August 7, 2020, the filing period will be extended to August 12, 2020. During this extended period, persons other than the incumbent may execute a Declaration of Candidacy and file Nomination Papers for the office.

The Board of Supervisors is authorized to canvass the returns of this District election and certify the results to the District.
